### 1. READING EBOOKS USING THE POCKETBOOK READER MOBILE APP

Follow these steps to open your ebook:

A. Make sure that **you have an Adobe ID on the Adobe website**. If you don't have an Adobe ID yet, create one here: https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html. In the upper right corner, click on "Log in" and then "Create an account". Confirm your registration by clicking on the link sent to you by email.




B. **Download the PocketBook Reader app** for iOS or Android.





Once the app is installed, be sure to **sign in with your Adobe ID**. To do this on your mobile phone, follow these simple instructions: Settings > Accounts > AdobeDRM.



C. Now that your application has been authorised and you are logged in with your Adobe ID, click on the link to download the ebook. Once the ebook file is downloaded, click "Open in PocketBook application". PocketBook Reader opens your ebook and displays it for reading.


### 2. READING AN EBOOK USING THE ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS (ADE) APP

Follow these steps to open your ebook:

A. Make sure that **you have an Adobe ID on the Adobe website**. If you don't have an Adobe ID yet, create one here: https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html. In the upper right corner, click on "Log in" and then "Create an account". Confirm your registration by clicking on the link sent to you by email.



B. **Download the Adobe Digital Editions app** for iOS or Android.



Once the app is installed, be sure to log in with your Adobe ID. To do this on your mobile phone, follow these simple instructions: Menu > Settings > Authorise.

C. Now that your application has been authorised and you are logged in with your Adobe ID, click on the link to download the ebook. Once the ebook file is downloaded, click "Open with: Adobe Digital Editions". ADE opens your ebook and displays it for reading.

### 3. READING EBOOKS ON PC OR MAC


If you are downloading your ebook to your PC or Mac, continue reading.

Follow these steps to open your ebook:

A. Make sure that **you have an Adobe ID on the Adobe website**. If you don't have an Adobe ID yet, create one here: https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html. In the upper right corner, click on "Log in" and then "Create an account". Confirm your registration by clicking on the link sent to you by email.




B. Download and install the latest version of Adobe Digital Editions on your computer.




Once Adobe Digital Edition is installed on your PC or Mac, be sure to sign in with your Adobe ID.

C. Now that Adobe Digital Editions has been authorised and you are logged in with your Adobe ID, click on the link to download the ebook. Once the ebook file has been downloaded, click "Open file with" Adobe Digital Editions (default), and ADE will open the ebook and display it for reading. Some web browsers (e.g. Google Chrome and Opera) do not provide an option to "Open file with" by default, and instead automatically save the file.



If the ebook is automatically saved to your computer, you can open the file directly in Adobe Digital Editions. From the menu, select File > Add to Library. Another option is to drag and drop the ACSM file directly into Adobe Digital Editions.
